

Sustainability Policy

Cotton & Grey (“us”, “we”, or “our”) operates the Cotton & Grey website (the “Service”).

This page informs you of our policies regarding sustainability.

Corporate Responsibility

We take the environment seriously. As a company we are aware that we have a responsibility to do all we can to minimise our impact on the environment, and we are proud of our commitment to improve our “green” credentials and to work on solutions to reduce our carbon footprint. We believe that by working together with our customers, we can make our own small but important contribution to this goal. Please see below details on what we have achieved so far and our aims for the future.

Sourcing

Where possible, we source British materials to minimise our carbon footprint. We avoid plastic wherever possible and do not use single-use plastics.

Gift Wrapping Service

Our Gift Wrap is fully recyclable. We use gift wrapping paper that is made from 100% recycled paper, with no chemical components or plastics used in the production process. It is fully recyclable. Our ribbon is made from recycled craft paper and is fully recyclable. Our paper stickers are made from craft paper and are plastic and acid free, compostable and recyclable.

Packaging

We recycle all inbound packaging and only source paper which is 100% recyclable, biodegradable, compostable and made from 100% recycled paper and FSC certified. The tissue paper we use is made from virgin wood pulp from sustainable sources. It can be recycled with paper/cardboard (it is 100% recyclable) or used again. We only use plastic from inbound received goods. Occasionally, our customers will receive orders wrapped using air-bags, bubble wrap or polystyrene chips. This is because we always strive to re-use wrapping materials received during deliveries from our suppliers.
